Responsibilities

- Release of medicinal products to the local market
- Act as the main contact point for the Regulatory Authority regarding the distribution of medicinal products
- Collect, investigate, and report incidents and product complaints, with proper escalation of issues
- Submit regular reports to the Regulatory Authority
- Perform on-site checks in Budapest (approx. weekly or as needed)
- Manage imports of unlicensed products and foreign language packages
- Verify customer status
- Coordinate and promptly execute recall operations
- Decide on final disposition of returned, rejected, recalled, or falsified products
- Manage transfers, blocking, and unblocking of medicinal products in the stock evidence system
- Monitor Regulatory Authority websites to stay up to date with local and European regulatory requirements
- Conduct self-inspections and manage quality audits

Requirements

- University degree in pharmacy, medicine, veterinary medicine, chemistry, pharmaceutical chemistry, chemical engineering, pharmaceutical chemical engineering, bioengineering, or biology (or a closely related field).
- Proven hands-on experience under Good Distribution Practice (GDP) in a wholesale/distribution or GDP-QA environment (e.g., RP, deputy RP, QA under GDP).
- Active English (spoken/written).
